From Cincinnati:

Take I-71 North to Exit 45 (Waynesville), then 7 miles West on State Route 73 to the festival. Or, take I-75 North to Exit 38 (Springboro/Franklin) then 13 miles East on State Route 73.

From Dayton:

Take I-75 South to Exit 38 (Springboro/Franklin), then 13 miles East on State Route 73 to the entrance. Or, take State Route 48 to State Route 73, then East on State Route 73.

You may also take Rt. 35 East, to the Rt. 35 by-pass towards Lebanon. Stay on Rt. 42 for 15 miles to the festival.

From Columbus:

Take I-71 South to Exit 45 (Waynesville), then 2 miles West on State Route 73 to the festival.

From Toledo:

Take I-75 South to Exit 38 (Springboro/Franklin), then 13 miles East on State Route 73 to the festival.

From Indianapolis:

Take I-70 East to Dayton, then I-75 South to Exit 38 (Springboro/Franklin), then 13 miles East on State Route 73 to the festival. Or, take I-74 East to Cincinnati, then I-75 North to Exit 38 (Springboro/Franklin), then 13 miles East on State Route 73.

From Louisville:

Take I-71 North to Exit 45 (Waynesville), then 7 miles West on State Route 73 to the corner of Rt. 73 & Rt.42. The festival is located approximately 45 minutes north of downtown Cincinnati.

From Lexington:

Take I-75 North to Cincinnati, then take I-71 North to Exit 45 (Waynesville), then 7 miles West on State Route 73 to the corner of Rt. 73 & Rt 42. The festival is located approximately 45 minutes from downtown Cincinnati.
